



1st floor

DINING Room

$\frac{1}{4}$ square = 1 ft.




* Notes: Photos #A-16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25

- *1. West wall under the bay window. From the wall to 4 boards out - the 4 boards are $3\frac{7}{16}$ " wide, the rest of the floor boards in the room are $3\frac{1}{4}$ " wide. The $3\frac{7}{16}$ " boards are tongue and groove, whereas the $3\frac{1}{4}$ " boards are two grooves.
- *2. The floor boards are $3\frac{1}{4}$ " wide. See note *1.
- *3. The height from floor to ceiling is $119\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- *4. The first layer of wallpaper is large white flowers with red leaves. (Flowers look like poinsettias) N #12, 13 - photo taken on west wall.
- *5. There is a cut border (frieze) on all the walls, except for this one (East wall).

DINING ROOM - NORTH WALL.


$\frac{1}{4}$ " square = 6"



*Notes:

- *1. No paint or plaster coat, just under the mouldings (plate rail).
- *2. Wood under plaster coat, chair rail markings(?)
- *3. Number 18 written in pencil on the wall, 4"x5". P#36
- *4. Addition (numbers) written on the walls, 2"x3". Q#1
- *5. One line, looks like this: 4y 10", $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide and 2" long. Q#2.

Dining Room - EAST WALL.



$\frac{1}{4}$ " square = 6"

*Notes:

- *1. Plastered hole, goes through to the other side (Plastered on that side too), is 6" wide. P#34.
- *2. The plaster on this wall is very thin, only $\frac{1}{8}$ " thick. See Stairs and Stair-Hall (XVI) for the other side of the wall.
